

MASTER CLASS ETIQUETTE & TIPS

ALWAYS COME PROPERLY DRESSED

Be dressed to dance for whatever type of class it is. You should look well put together. Hair should be cleanly off your face so it's not distracting. Clothes should make you stand out, but is danceable.

NEVER MARK DURING CLASS

You should never mark during a master class. You are getting an opportunity to learn from someone who does this professionally in the industry. Don't waste the opportunity because you feel tired.

ARRIVE EARLY

Nothing shows a bigger lack of respect than arriving after class was expected to begin. Arrive at least 15 minutes prior and begin stretching. This will also help you to get a better spot in the room so you are noticed more.

BE RESPECTFUL

There is nothing wrong with asking questions. However, remember to use the golden rules of please, thank you, yes sir, no m'am, Applaud other dancers for doing something correctly. Always thank your instructor at the completion of class.
